## **Frequently Asked Questions**

## What does "working a casino" mean?

All casinos in Alberta require volunteers for them to run. Volunteers are responsible for the count room.

Some of the roles to fill are:

- Take chips to game tables when they need to be re-filled.
- Pay out customers who want to cash in the chips they have been using.
- Count the money the game tables have brought in during the day.

All jobs are computerized and there is a paid supervisor to walk everyone through the process.

#### Who can work in the casino count room?

Anyone who is 18 years of age and over, who does not have a criminal conviction and has not excluded themselves from entering a casino. You do not need a police clearance.

Volunteers can be grandparents, uncles, aunts, friends and adult siblings. No experience necessary.

### How do we get there?
